# So, Pray

A small boy was asked if he ever prayed. In answering the question

the boy made a wise and profound distinction. He said, "Sometimes I pray, but sometimes I just say my prayers." There is a world of difference between "saying our prayers" and experiencing the power of prayer.

Prayer is not talking. Prayer is listening. Prayer changes things and one of the first things it changes is us. H. William Gregory, in his book *And the Answer Is Yes!* writes that "Prayer is not a magic lamp. It is not something we can hold in our hands and fondle, calling forth some genie in the sky to make our wishes come true and produce for us whatever the deepest desires of our hearts might be. That is not an adequate model for prayer."

How do you change the station on your TV set? Well, if you don't stand up, walk to the set, and turn a knob, how do you change the channel? We like to push a button from across the room and get an instant result. Remote controls allow us to have complete control without effort and we love it. Have we grown too accustomed to the idea of being in effortless control? We often try to use

prayer as a remote-control device to get the "channels" and "programs" we want. Can we push a button and change God?

"Prayer is not a way to get what we want to happen, like the remote control that comes with the television set," writes Rachel Naomi Remen. "These remote-control devices are handy. No doubt about it. But here's the deal: Prayer is not about getting control; it is about giving up control. When we pray, we don't change the world, we change ourselves." We set ourselves up for disappointment when we expect God to change the world according to our vision. Maybe God has a different vision of healing, wholeness, happiness, peace, strength and than we do. success

So, pray! Pray what's on your heart! God is listening. God loves you. God will understand. You may not get the answer you expect, you may not even understand the answer at first, but an answer will come and that answer may well be a new way of seeing, a new way of being you.




