There is positive ChristNet news to share this month. First of all, work

has restarted on the completion of our Daytime Center. Windows have been ordered and workers are concentrating on the outside work that needs to be done on the building before the colder weather sets in. There is still a shortage of building materials which may cause slowdowns, but we are finally moving forward!!

Also, we are partnering with Wayne Metro to house ChristNet overnight guests again this season in a local motel. Because of the continuing COVID cases, many churches are just not able to house in their buildings. Churches are being asked again this year to prepare and deliver dinners to the motel during what would be their regular host week.

Faith's normal host week is the end of February into the first few days of March, which is **February 27 - March 5, 2022.** The dinners will be prepared as usual, but instead of being able to serve them, they will be boxed in carry out containers and delivered to the motel. All of our ChristNet churches miss the close contact with the guests, as we do, and the guests miss the love and hospitality, which is sad. However, this motel model does allow us to continue our main mission of providing food and shelter for the homeless.
