The temperatures have become milder, the days are shorter, and some of the

leaves are falling off of the trees. The indicators of autumn are all around us, and remind us of God's design of the cycle of change throughout the year. We hear in Scripture, "As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night will never cease" (Genesis 8:27). Even when the seasons of life change, God's Presence is a constant comfort. Jesus told the disciples, "And surely I am with you to the end of the age" (Matthew Our circumstances change, while 28:20). God's Presence remains consistent. In the same way, how we do something may change, while our purpose remains the same. I've experienced this a number of years ago when my doctor listened to my knees and advised me to stop jogging, and engage in low impact exercise, such as cycling. My intent and purpose to exercise and stay fit remained the same, but my method changed.

At Faith UMC throughout our history we have been a church dedicated to missions, fellowship, devotion to Jesus, and being part of our community. We are a church which has welcomed thousands of people into the fellowship of faith and engaged people in mission. We crafted our mission statement to

reflect these values: <u>Being disciples by loving</u> <u>God, loving people, and making a difference</u> <u>together</u>. Last month we featured our vision statement in worship:

We are committed to the heart and purpose of Faith UMC and are continuing to find new ways to be faithful and to live our vision. A group of our leaders (The Faith Assessment Band) met for the last three months. They reflected on our history, assessed our current situation, and learned about the demographics of our community and Jesus' vision for churches. They also brain stormed about how we could engage in ministry. We celebrated ways we are faithful to Jesus' calling, many of which you heard about in worship last month. We also looked at new ways that we can engage in Jesus' mission. The ideas will be shared with Administrative Council in the next month, who will have an opportunity to reflect upon them and discern which ones will be priorities. Please pray for God's inspiration to guide our congregation and to bless us so that we will continue God's purpose at Faith UMC. We are grateful for all God has done at Faith UMC, and anticipate God's continued goodness and love in us and through us.

I am sure none of us expected the pandemic to continue for so long.

and everyone is challenged by the need to adapt our daily lives according to each new turn of events. ChristNet is no different. We have had to rethink every part of our program, both the day center program and the nighttime shelter program.

As we look towards the upcoming season, we are still unsure of the next steps. We cannot go back to a rotating shelter model at this time, and Wayne Metro will continue working with us to house the guests at night. This will most likely continue as last year, with Wayne Metro housing guests at a local motel. We believe Wayne Metro will need our assistance with providing evening meals, as we did last year. I will let you know as soon as we have further information so that Faith can participate.

Our daytime center at Church of the Nazarene continues to provide needed services to the homeless. The center is open daily, seven days a week, from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. With the help of many churches and dedicated volunteers, at least 25 bag lunches daily have been provided for our **Daytime Center ChristNet guests** since April, 2020. During these past 18 months, approximately 13,500 lunches have been delivered and enjoyed. Several members from our church graciously help with the lunch ministry which is a necessary and important part of the ChristNet ministry. If you would like to be involved, please give me a call.

I do not have any new updates on the new ChristNet Daytime Center being completed. Progress has been very slow. We remain prayerful and hopeful, as its completion will allow us to provide so many more services for the homeless we serve.

ChristNet, along with every organization and individual, has experienced many challenges this past year. Please keep the ChristNet program, as well as the homeless we serve, in your prayers.

There is no prep work requiredjust sign-up and enjoy this fun time with our students! I would also love to have our High School students volunteer with one of our adult teachers or parents. They can use this time as volunteer hours for National Honors Society and other organizations that may require volunteer opportunities. Please reach out to me if your high schooler may be interested.

If you have a third grade student, please let me know as soon as possible so I can order enough Bibles for our students. We will be celebrating our third graders on a Sunday in October. If you would like to sponsor one of our third grade students, please let me know. This is a wonderful way to get to personally know one of our young children, here at Faith. Our third graders love to receive mail, porch drop-offs, or even a phone call/text from their Bible Sponsors! It's a wonderful ministry that we have been doing at Faith for many, many years!
