Joy and I are blessed to join with you in serving our Lord. We continue to experience the depth of love of the congregation and community. Faith

UMC is blessed to be a blessing and every week I see people who help one another by providing transportation and food, visiting and assistance, as well as being present with each other in many ways. As we move forward in faith, God will do wonderful things in us, through us, and around us.

In September, I've shared about God's grace through Jesus, in whom we experience love, are forgiven, strengthened, and have eternal hope. Dallas Willard asserts, "...without grace we can do nothing, but our action is also required". Jesus taught about God's way, and always challenged his disciples/students to respond. God's grace is lavished upon us, and like Jesus' disciples, I believe God is calling us to respond in four ways:

- Prayers: Paul tells us, "...but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God" (Philippians 4:6). Jesus taught his disciples about prayer in Luke 11, and concluded by saying, "If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him?" (Luke 11:13). Prayer is talking to and listening to God. When our prayers are focused we are in God's Presence. I ask that you pray for our congregation, especially our children and youth programs. You can take a bold step by praying for our youth in the Pray For Me ministry.
- Passion: Passion is what excites you and engages you. Jesus told us the greatest

commands were, 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' (Matthew 22:37-39). I translate the verses, "Love the Lord, and love our neighbors as ourselves with everything we've got". What excites you and how do you connect it to your love for God and others?

- Presence: Someone once said, 80% of life is showing up. While we may agree or disagree on the percentage, it is true that you will not succeed if you do not show up. Faith Church needs your presence, because you bring a distinctive blessing of God which no one else can offer. I also believe, if you show up, you will grow. My prayer is that every person will grow in faith, and Faith will grow because of every person.
- Purpose: Purpose is your motivation in life. It is your vision which inspires your mission. At Faith Church our purpose is to love, follow, and glorify God, and in doing so share the love of God with all people so they will experience Jesus. My hope and prayer is we will fulfill Jesus' command to make disciples of all groups (Matthew 28). Thus, we will fulfill Jesus' purpose for the church. We are doing so at Faith Church, and I believe God will bless us as we continue to live God's purpose in Trenton.



Outreach/Radical Hospitality Group Update

I want to update you on some of the Outreach activities we have in place and let you know about a couple of ideas that we are mulling around.

Faith in the Community - Adult/Youth Mission projects

As you will recall, we decided to stay in town this year for our adult mission trip and have the youth join us where they can. So far, we have four projects that we have undertaken:

- 1. Painting a condo. Thanks to Bob and Leanna Maxwell and Dave Ware, this project has been completed.
- 2. Installing a dryer, which included updating the electrical and fixing the dryer vent. Thanks to Todd Cleaver, this project has been completed.
- 3. Replacing shutters on a house. This project will be completed soon.
- 4. Gutting and installing a new bathroom (shower, toilet, vanity, faucet, flooring), fixing the main floor joists, and possibly replacing the current HVAC system in a trailer owned by a single mom with three children. Thanks to donations received, we have been able to order the shower enclosure. We are awaiting word on whether or not we will receive additional funds that will enable us to complete the bathroom remodel and replace the HVAC system.

Time to Share is a newly formed 501(c)(3) organization formed by Todd and Linda Cleaver to help the homeless who have been granted housing with government assistance. They provide the necessary things that are needed for a new home; things like a couch or chair, a bed, dishes, lamps, towels, pots and pans, etc. Maintaining this organization has been costly. Monetary donations are needed to help offset the cost of the storage units, gas, along with costs associated with obtaining supplies needed by the individuals that have not been donated; things like converters for televisions, shower curtains, and miscellaneous necessities.

Card Making

This program started in December 2018 and is headed by Laura Trosien. To date they have completed over 800 cards for both members of Faith and people in the community that need the encouragement that receiving a card can bring. No special skills are needed...Laura makes it so easy to create a beautiful card.

Clothing Closet

This Outreach program began in July 2020, right in the middle of the pandemic. On average, 40 bags or more of clothing are taken per month by those who visit the closet...and we are only open one day a week! Thank you Leann Maxwell, Judy Kroll, and Renee MacKay for your faithful service to this project. And we have a newbie that has begun to help...Gary Lynch!

Porch Blessings

This brainstorm of Linda Cleaver's began back in February with the delivery of heart shaped cookies; then there were chocolate pretzels and refrigerator magnets. Soon there will be another delivery, but this time you'll be asked to pass on a magnet to a friend or neighbor! Thank you to all the people that volunteer to help create the blessings and those that help to deliver them...all 200+ of them!

Book Library

Have you noticed the beautiful book library on our Nichols side lawn? Laura Trosien painted those exquisite pictures on the library; and BJ Williams is responsible for the books we make available to the community. It has been suggested we brighten up the area even more with a nice bench and maybe some mulch around the post??

Golf League

Now you might think that a church golf league has nothing to do with Outreach. But I would say you are wrong! Many, many guests have joined us...Mike Oakley brings Art, his father-in-law; Aldo Colapietro brings friends from work; Jim Allison brings Austin, a teenage neighbor that enjoys golf and now has joined the Gabriel Richard Golf Team! Kay Korns brings friends from her ladies' golf league; and recently our son-in-law, Coty, has joined us for a round or two.

Bread Ministry

Long ago, Bob Maxwell would deliver a fresh loaf of bread to first time visitors. Linda Cleaver recently decided that this ministry should be reinstated, and made banana bread for the senior card players we had in Compton Hall as well as a ladies' quilting group that uses our church facilities on a monthly basis. Both groups were pleasantly surprised by this Radical Hospitality!

Christnet

Linda Dickman continues to ensure that guests at the Christnet warming center are able to enjoy lunch on a daily basis by gathering volunteers to make and deliver 25 lunches to the day time center in Taylor.

And then we have new programs or events that we are planning.

<u>Card Club</u>: Judy Kroll likes to play cards and wants to start a card playing group here at Faith. Her plan is to play cards on Tuesday afternoon at 1:00 p.m. and Thursday evenings at 6:30 p.m. Both groups would meet every other week. Look for a sign-up sheet soon!

<u>Garden Club</u>: We are hoping to start a group that would plant and tend a community garden at Faith. We have plans to build and maintain raised gardens along the North side of the parking lot (behind/by the dumpster). These vegetables would be available either for people to just pick or maybe made available at our Clothing Closet for people to take.

Shred Day: We did this a few years ago, where we hired a shred company and then invited the community to bring their papers that needed to be shred. This is a great Community Outreach project and I'm hoping to be able to do this once again in October.

Dessert with Donna - An Advent Event

Our very own Donna Spencer has agreed to speak at this event. This will be a ladies only event, where members of Faith will reserve a table and then invite their friends and neighbors to join them. As host, the member will provide the table settings and dessert to share with their quests.

Let's continue to glorify God through our Outreach and Radical Hospitality and serve with the gifts that God has given us.


Faith's PRODUCE SHARING July 11 - Sept 12
