October 20th, 2019

Pastor Chris Ortego, moderator, called meeting to order and Bro. Rick Willis offered opening prayer.

Brandy Taylor took roll of the association churches in attendance. Eleven churches were represented with 40 messengers in attendance. A motion and a second was made to seat the messengers. Motion carried.

The minutes for the 2018 annual meeting were presented. A motion and a second was made to accept the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

F.A. Taylor presented the finance report. A motion and a second was made to accept the report as presented.

New Business: The proposed officers and committees were presented. A motion and a second was made to accept the officers and committees for 2020. Motion carried.

The proposed budget was presented for 2020. F.A. Taylor made note that the budget for the new year had been lowered by \$22,050 from last year. A motion and a second was made to accept the 2020 budget as presented. Discussion: A question was asked if the decrease was due to lower projected income for 2020? F.A Taylor said that we have had a decrease in money coming into the association and the reduction was due to that. A statement was made that budget looks to be about \$3000.00 in line with budget expenses so far. Vote taken. Motion carried.

The proposed calendar for 2020 was presented. Chris Ortego made note of an added date for the Lampasas Association Music Festival for April 26th at Clear Creek Baptist Church. The leadership team meeting in January will be at School Creek at 6:30pm. There are other dates

that will be added as they come up throughout the year. A motion and a second was made to accept the calendar as presented with the added date. Discussion: A question was asked about the date for Baptist Women's Day of prayer. Betty Rials said that the 1st Monday in November is always Baptist Women's Day of prayer the dates change from year to year. Motion carried.

Betty Rials presented the WMU report: Upcoming dates include Baptist Women's Day of Prayer to be held the 1st Monday In November. This year will be November 4th. Adamsville Baptist Church will host the prayer day from 10:30am -1:00pm. Bring a sack Lunch to trade. Mission Gathering for International Missions will be December 7th, 10:00 am at Cove Korean Baptist Church.

Rusty Brandan gave Highland Lakes report. This year at camp there was a total of 9000 students with 697 students that found Jesus and 325 dedications to ministry. He thanked the association for the support and asked for the continued prayers for new opportunities and activities at the camp. All of these things help to bring the light of Jesus into someone's life.

A question was asked if we would get a report from Heart of Texas Camp. Chris Ortego said that we have not had a report from them but would investigate that for the future.
