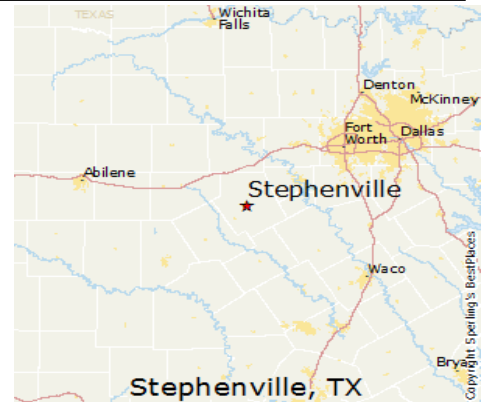
Calvary Baptist Church seeks Part-Time Music Minister

Music Minister Responsibility

- Direct the planning, organizing, conducting and evaluating of the church music program, including choirs, praise teams and other vocal and instrumental groups.
- Supervise the work of paid music staff and volunteer workers.
- Work with the Church Nominating Committee to enlist and train leaders for the church music and worship ministry, including accompanists and graded choir leaders.
- Serve as a member of the Church Council; coordinate the music and worship program with the church calendar and emphases of the church.
- Lead in planning and promoting a graded choir program; direct and coordinate the work of choir directors. Direct adult, student and other choirs as needed.
- Assist the pastor in planning all worship services.
- Arrange and provide music for weddings, funerals, special events and other church-related activities upon request.
- Maintain music library, materials, supplies, musical instruments and other equipment.
- Prepare an annual music and worship budget for approval. Administrate approved budget.
- Cooperate with the local association and denominational leaders in promoting activities of mutual interest.
- Perform other duties as assigned by Pastor.
