The church morale is high as we are looking to find our next pastor and continue in service to the Lord Jesus Christ.



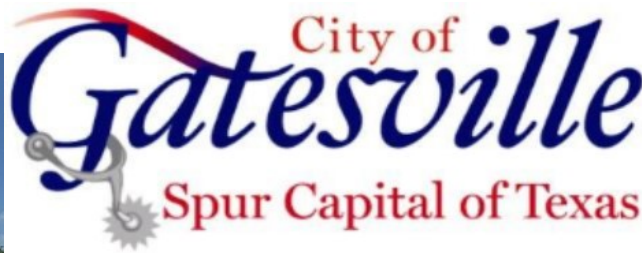

Our Location

Trinity Baptist Church is located in Gatesville, Texas, the county seat of Coryell County. The population of Gatesville is over 12,000 people and is located within 40 miles of Waco, Texas. Gatesville has a long, rich history and was established in 1854 near Ft. Gates. Today, Gatesville is located near North Ft. Hood. The school district is classified as 4A by the University Interscholastic League.



Trinity Baptist Church History and Facilities

In August 1976, approximately 35 individuals, informally but prayerfully, met to pray and consider the direction God was taking them. From that meeting the idea took root that God was working through those present to create a new work, and on October 31, 1976, 116 individuals signed the charter book as members of Trinity Baptist Church. The church had petitioned and received acceptance as the 27th member church of Coryell Baptist Association.

The remainder of the year was spent in selecting pastoral search and building site committees, organizing the various programs of the church, writing the church's constitution, buying property for a church building, and selecting the church's motto and logo. Much time was spent in prayer seeking the will of God in all things.

On April 28, 1977, the first dirt was moved at the building site and the new construction was underway. The building was dedicated and occupied for training, education, and worship on August 28, 1977. Since that time, Trinity Baptist Church has been blessed with 5 pastors. Our retiring pastor is leaving after 24 years at Trinity Baptist Church.

Trinity Baptist Church is set on 7 acres of land and has more than 36,000 square feet of building space between the main church building, the education building, and the annex building, which contains the administrative staff offices for Trinity Baptist Church.

- Supervise all church staff members
- Recommend staff training and development
- Preside over church business meetings as moderator
- Coordinate church-wide events
- Work jointly with established church committees in planning for budgetary and other church needs
