**All: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.**

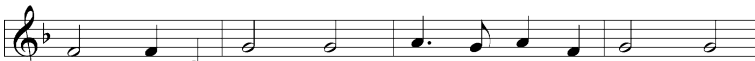

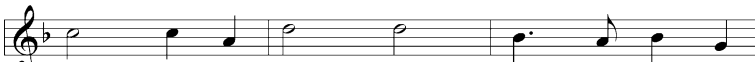

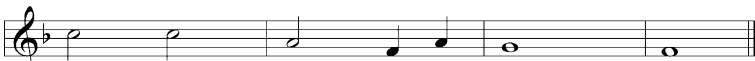
