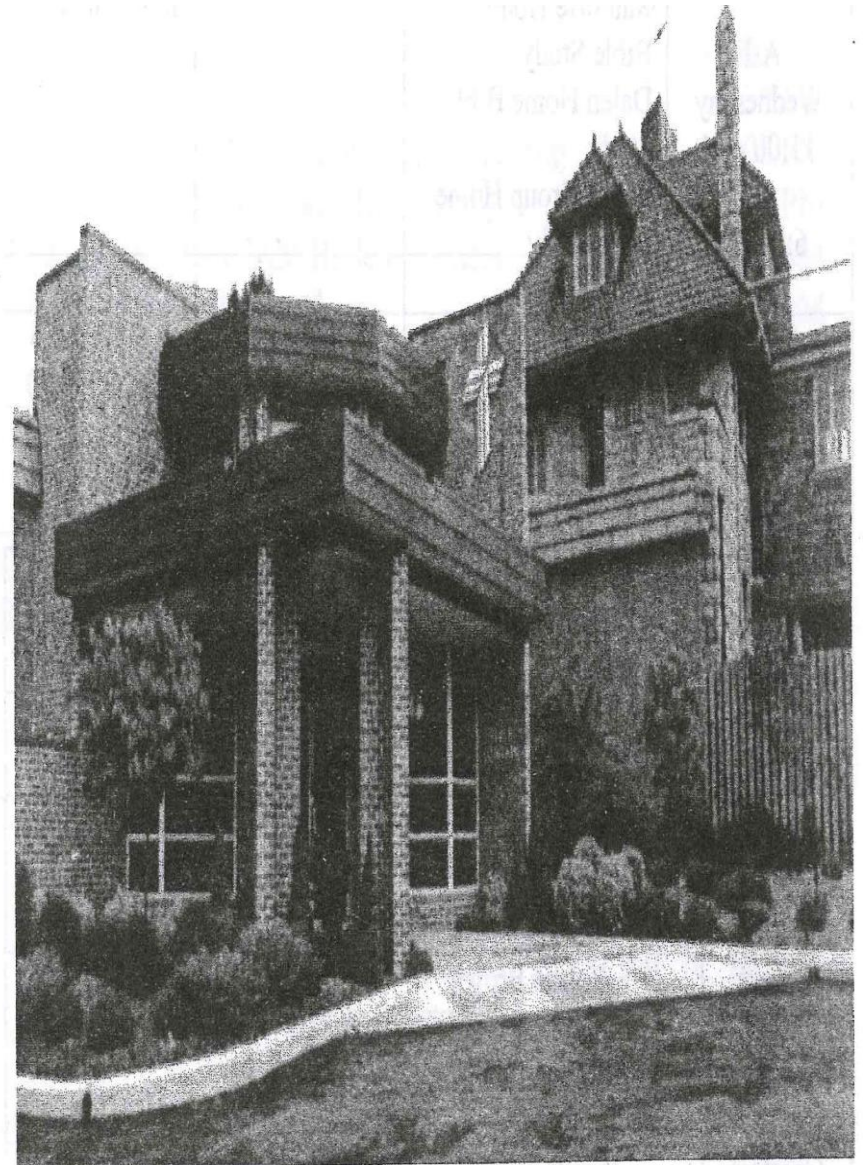
"10 Feet or \$10" Campaign
