

Who's Going to Be King?

Scripture: I will exalt you, my God the King; I will praise your name for ever and ever.
~ Psalm 145:1

Memo: In order to understand today's lesson, please read II Samuel 5:1-7, 9-10

In this story we find David being asked to serve as King. At thirty years old, the leaders of the tribes of Israel came to him and revealed that even when Saul was the ruler, David still led them in battle. They recognized God had given David favor and was the man chosen to be King. Therefore, they called for all Israel to come together and they anointed David as their king. David ruled Israel for forty years. David was able to capture the walled and fortified city of Jerusalem and set up this kingdom to be ruled from there. Just like David was chosen to be king by the people, we too must choose to whom will be king and ruler of our lives. Are we going to choose Jesus or something or someone else? How can we let Jesus be king in our lives?

Do you realize you can have a real king in your life and be apart of a royal family? Do you realize you can become a prince or princess to the greatest kingdom that has ever existed? You can! You can let the King of the whole world rule in your life from this moment on. He is the best King you could ever have—a King who loves you, who is powerful, who is completely fair—and a king who lives forever.

All you need to do is ask Him to be king of your heart. By doing that you become part of God's Kingdom and receive a nice welcoming rewards... You receive ETERNAL LIFE!
