IMPORTANT ADULT & STAFF REQUIREMENTS:

1. Safe Gatherings certified: All adults who participate in Midwinter retreat activities must be Safe Gatherings certified (or the equivalent) and bring proof of certification. Adults must be above reproach and be a growing disciple of Jesus Christ. Midwinter reserves the right to refuse admission to any adult who does not meet these requirements.
2. Payment and Registration: All adults must pay full price and send complete registration form with payment to the Crossroads District office.
3. Sponsor Ratio: Youth Groups should bring a 1 adult to 5 students ratio to help with supervision, rooming, and small groups.
4. SERVANT TEAM: a leadership opportunity. Each church is encouraged to submit the names of students who are willing to apply to be a part of the SERVANT Team. This team of students (ages 16+) will assist in serving during the week of camp in addition to being participants themselves.
