The Brodhead United Methodist Church is hosting two men's health educational events on April 18 and 25, 2017, from 9-10:30 a.m. On April 18, 2017, information will be provided on cardiac issues. It will include signs and symptoms that should alert you to seek medical attention, important indicators that could cause heart problems and those things that you can do to help improve heart health.

On April 25, 2017, the presentations will include information on the leading men's cancers; skin, bowel, and prostate.

Presenters will be senior nursing students from Edgewood College in Madison, along with Vicki Evenson, the Parish Nurse at the Methodist Church.
