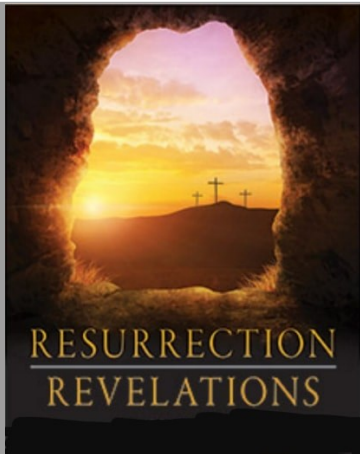

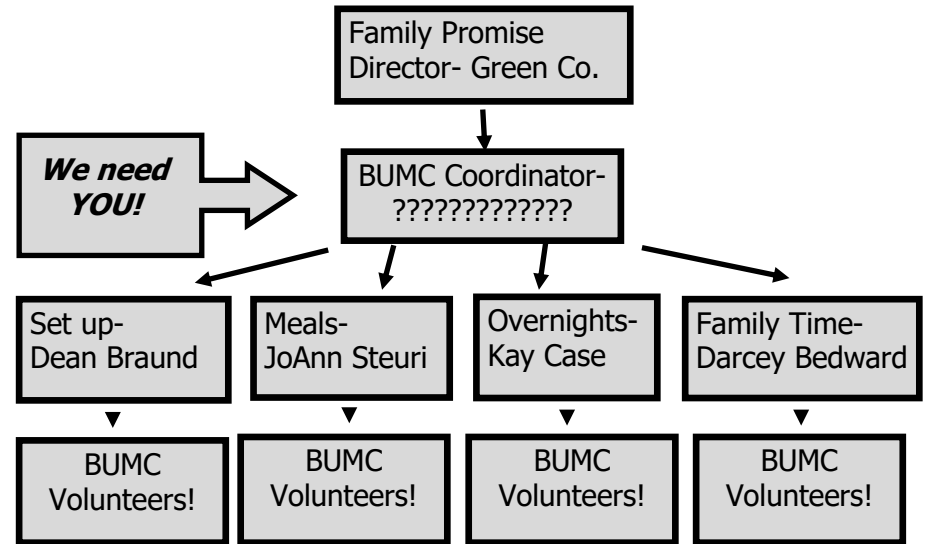
## Ready? Here we go!
