WHAT IS PRAYERWALKING?



God is stirring us to take our prayers beyond the walls of our church buildings. We are putting feet to our prayers. This type of action based prayer is called "prayerwalking." It's simply praying in the very places that we expect God to bring forth His answers. In teams of at least two people, we will walk down a street and pray for every house and those who live in them.

Peace in my neighbors' relationships with others.
(Colossians 3:12-15)

Blessings of safety, health, wisdom, work and salvation for my neighbors. (Psalm 34:7; Proverbs 2:1-11; Ephesians 1:16-18; Psalm 90:17; Acts 26:18)
