This week: We are Family. Which step are you on?

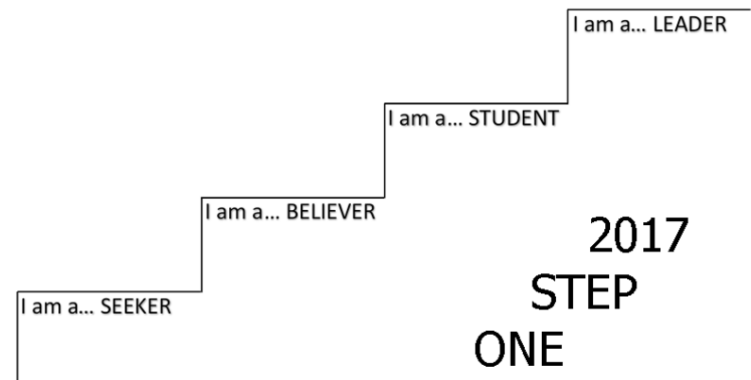
#1 I am a Seeker: I know no one here.
