INVITATION, CONFESSION and PARDON

Invitation:

Leader: Jesus Christ our King, the Great Emancipator, invites to His table all who love Him, who earnestly repent of their sin and seek to live in peace with one another. There is great freedom in forgiveness! The Psalmist acknowledged, "When I refused to confess my sin, my body wasted away, and I groaned all day long. My strength was sapped as in the heat of summer. Finally, I confessed all my sins to You and You forgave me!" So, let *us* confess *our* sin to God!

Confession and Pardon:

People: Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your faithful love. Wash me completely clean of my guilt; purify me from my sin. Because I know my wrongdoings, my sin is always right in front of me. I've sinned against You – You alone. That's why You are justified when You render Your verdict, completely correct when You issue Your judgment. Create a clean heart for me, God; put a new, faithful spirit deep inside me! Amen.

Leader: The Lord *is* merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His steadfast love for those who fear Him; as far as the east is from the west, so far He removes our transgressions from us.
