THE TEN COMMANDMENTS OF VOLUNTEER SERVICE

- 1. SERVE WITH JOY!** Seek opportunities to share with others how you love serving.
- 2. SEEK BALANCE IN YOUR LIFE.** Your relationship with God is your top priority, and serving is an outgrowth of that relationship.
- 3. RADIATE ENTHUSIASM.** Positive energy and enthusiasm are contagious!
- 4. BE CHRIST-LIKE.** Try to see others through the eyes of Jesus – eyes of love.
- 5. BE ENCOURAGING.** Words either build others up or tear them down. Choose to encourage others.
- 6. BE GENEROUS.** Make the words "thank you" the most commonly used words in your vocabulary.
- 7. VALUE THE TIME OF OTHERS.** Being responsive and prompt shows that you value others as you do yourself – and helps your leader avoid stress.
- 8. BE LOYAL.** We may not agree with every decision that is made, but as leaders in this church we are called to be faithful and loyal.
- 9. SHARE YOUR KNOWLEDGE.** Teach and mentor other volunteers about your service role. That way, when the Lord leads you into another area of ministry, transitions will go smoothly.
- 10. MOVING ON**when you hear a call to another ministry, or a time of renewal, let us know.
