Suggested Iconography for 12 Windows

Each window to contain a single figure of one of the twelve Apostles with either Paul or Matthias in place of Judas.

Each window might contain a small scene below the Apostle figure which would show the Ongoing Church. Thus the Apostolic Church is linked with present day Christianity in somewhat the same way that in a window in Chartres Cathedral the four Evangelists are seated on the shoulders of the four major prophets symbolizing the debt of an age to the heritage of the past.
