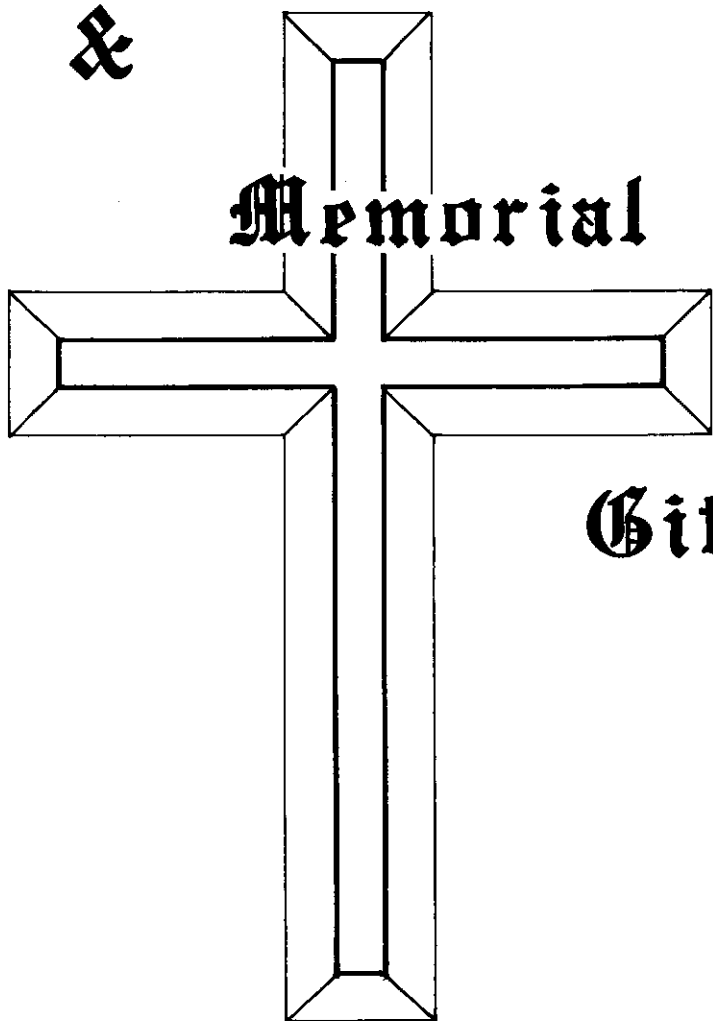

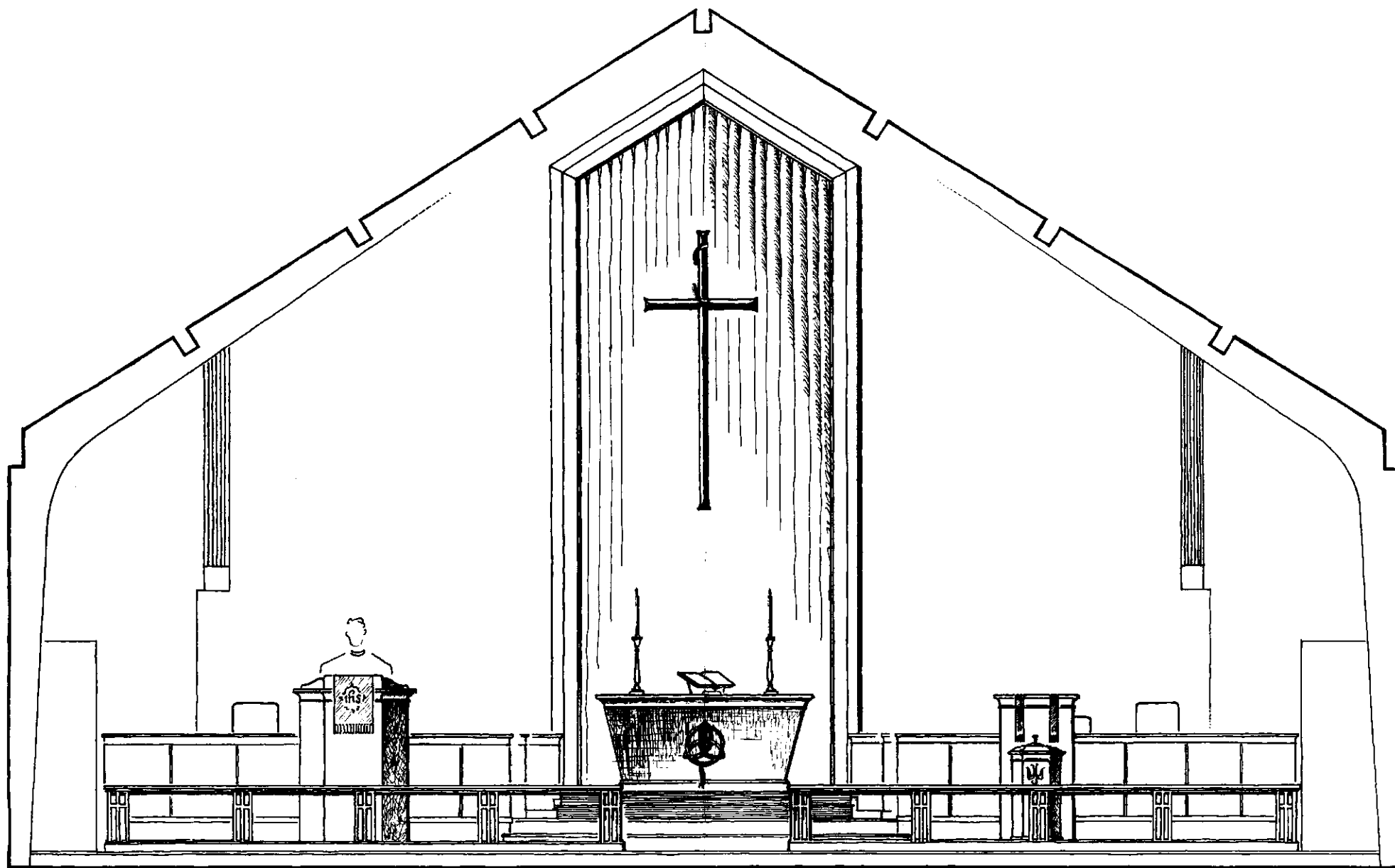
- \*1. MAIN ALTAR - 7 foot width, platinum \$

symbols. 825.
- \*2. DOSSAL - 24 foot shaped oak frame with  
cotten-velvet cloth sewed 75%  
full. 850.
- \*3. ALTAR CROSS - 9 foot height, gold-  
leafed, free-suspension against  
dossal cloth. 350.
- \*4. CANDLESTICKS - 2 foot height, carved  
oak with gold polychrome. (pair) 165.
- 5. BRASS ALTAR CANDELABRA - five light,  
with adjustable arms. (pair) 95.
- \*6. MISSAL STAND - carved oak, slanting  
face, to hold altar Bible. 50.
- \*7. ALTAR BIBLE - King James version.  
Red morocco leather, gold detail,  
special paper, and large print. 85.
- \*8. FLOWER STANDS - oak, floor-based, with  
matching formica tops. (pair) 135.
- \*9. FLOWER VASES - Oak, custom-carved,  
with removable copper liners. 135.

*10. CANDLE EXTENDERS - with symbols.	\$

17. SILVER COMMUNION SERVICE - trays, bread plates, bases and covers, to serve 450.		795.
*18. COMMUNION TOOLS - washer, filler, extra cups.		45.
*19. COMMUNION LINENS - heavy white Irish linen, 110 inch width, hand- hemmed, with symbols. Two (each)		40.

- \*24. ADDITIONAL ORGAN "STOPS" - to extend  
range and brilliance of our fine  
organ. From \$500. to 5,000.
25. AMERICAN FLAG - 4 & 1/3 x 5 & 1/2  
feet, Duralite nylon edged with  
gold-silk fringe, on 9 foot oak  
pole with brass base and eagle. 95.
26. CHRISTIAN FLAG - Same size and quality,  
with gold cross. 75.
- \*27. COMMUNION RAIL - oak, open-baluster,  
with custom-carved design. Velvet-  
covered foam rubber cushions.  
Full width of the nave. 1,000.

- \*28. PEWS - English oak, solid construction,  
form fitting, 16 feet 2 inches.  
36 in all. (each) 180.
- \*29. ADDITIONAL HYMNALS - for pews.  
Memorial bookplate for each donor.  
Minimum of 250. (each) 2.25
30. STAINED GLASS WINDOWS - twelve, each  
a selected episode within a theme  
chosen by official committee.  
each (approximately) 600.

main doors. 400.

\*38. ALMS BOXES - for voluntary gifts to the  
needy. Oak, wall-hung, drawers but

\*39. LITERATURE RACK - oak, wall-hung, with  
glass retainer strips. 160.

\*40. BULLETIN BOARD - oak, wall-hung, cork  
body. 70.

41. TOWER CHIMES SYSTEM - bells and music  
electronically recorded on tape .  
and broadcast through all-weather
