

SPECIAL NEEDS

Poundings:

When a family associated with the church is in need, a pounding may be organized. The following information should be obtained when a pounding is requested:

Family Size _____

Small Children _____

Specific Foods (Diet/Medical) _____

Once the pounding is brought to the church, it should be delivered to the family that is in need, or picked up at the church office.

Money:

The church does not have a budget set aside for giving financial assistance to people who come to the church office. We support both Faith Mission and Interfaith Ministries, and those requesting assistance are directed to apply at either of those centers for help. In special situations the church may take up a love offering for a specific need.

In order for a person in need to receive assistance from the church, they must either see the Pastor or Associate Pastor. They cannot receive money through the office secretary. If a specific bill needs to be paid, the person in need must bring the bill to the church office when making the request. Usually, such requests will be referred to Faith Mission or Interfaith Ministries.
