<b>NT Reference:</b> Jn. 4:23 – 24; Rom. 8:9; 12:1; Gal. 6:14,15; Eph. 2: 8 – 9
<b>Philippians 3:1 – 3</b> Finally, my brothers, rejoice in the Lord. To write the same things to you is no trouble to me and is safe for you. Look out for the dogs, look out for the evildoers, look out for those who mutilate the flesh. For we are the circumcision, who worship by the Spirit of $God^{[b]}$ and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh—
In this text, the Apostle Paul encourages the Philippians believers to, warns them of false teachers, and reminds them of what it means to be a follower of Jesus.

<sup>15</sup> Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you travel across sea and land to make a single proselyte, and when he becomes a proselyte, you make him twice as much a child of hell as yourselves. (Mat 23:15 ESV)
"Beware of those who would emphasize the legal observance of certain rituals to the exclusion of a commitment of heart to Jesus Christ." – James Draper
> Explanation of who we are as Christians.
For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation. (Gal 6:15 ESV)

This also means "serve" – worship is action.
It's the same kind of language in Romans 12:1
I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. (Rom 12:1 ESV)
<sup>23</sup> But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. <sup>24</sup> God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth." (Joh 4:23-24 ESV)
