

Supplies


- Paper or cardstock (four colors is preferable, but only white works too!)
- Scissors or paper cutter
- Stapler (or Tape)

Instructions

Phase 1: Print


Step 1: Print the Lent Chain Templates on colored paper or card stock. Please note that the links are organized into groups of 4 so that they can be assembled into a pattern of 4 alternating colors. Follow this guide when printing:

Page 1-2: Color #1 Page 3-4: Color #2 Page 5-6: Color #3 Page 7-8: Color #4



Phase 2: Cut

Using a paper cutter or scissors, cut along the lines separating each link.





Phase 3: Staple

Starting with #46, secure the link by overlapping the ends and staple to secure.

Next, loop #45 through the finished #46 link and secure.

Proceed with each link, going in consecutive order to create the finished chain.


Note: You can streamline your assembly by placing the links in colored stacks, with the numbers in order with the lowest number on bottom.




Phase 4: Display


- Try framing your Lent Calendar, and using Easter stickers or a dry erase marker to mark off each day.
- Hang the chain as a decorative garland on a wall.
- Place the chain on a mantle or desk so that you see it every day and remember to do the daily activity.






