Pearls of Wisdom from Grandparents

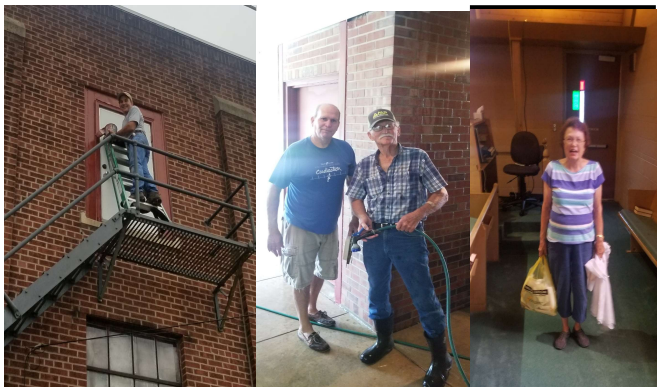
1. Treat others as you would like them to treat you.
