Treasurer's Recap for 2019

From a financial perspective, the year 2019 proved to be quite a year. THANK YOU for your financial support of God's ministry here at Grace Lutheran Church throughout 2019.

This past year became the year of the parking lot, which had been talked about and pushed off for some time. Thanks to the lead gift from the estate of Ralph and Lorraine Laskowski received in 2018, a contractor was lined up and, in between the spring rains, the old asphalt was removed and a concrete lot reappeared. In addition, lighting was added to the south side.

There were many wonderful gifts provided throughout the year for general operating, building fund, memorials, tuition, music, and the parking lot project. Grace Lutheran was truly blessed....again...in 2019!

Total 2019 gifts for general operating purposes were right at \$245,000 as some sizable gifts were received in late December. Our general expenses were just under budget, which was \$229,300, so we ended the year quite favorably. All bills were paid current at year end, and some carryover funds will be helpful during the lower giving months of the new year.

In addition to the gifts for general purposes, nearly \$27,000 was received to finish the parking lot project. Other gifts throughout the year included the final \$50,000 memorial distribution from the Laskowski estate, a \$5,000 anonymous gift, some memorials and tuition payments. The Laskowski gift will be added to the Scholarship Fund or an endowment fund. The anonymous gift was put into savings.

Please know your gifts for birthdays & anniversaries remain valuable as those gifts are being combined with our monthly budgeted "building fund" for unexpected repairs or other replacement projects. The only major project planned for 2020 is re-shingling of the parsonage, which will be paid for from the Building Fund.

Our operating budget for 2020 is up only 1.6% at \$232,300 or ~\$4,470/wk, as we provide for very modest increase in wages while lowering some other operating expenses. Also, we remain fortunate to not have any bank debt.

Thank you again for your ongoing support, and may you prayerfully determine your monetary and non-monetary gifts to our Lord's service at Grace Lutheran throughout each month ahead.
