

Unlike Baptism this Sacrament is to be received again and again for forgiveness and the strengthening of our Christian faith. Also in faithfulness to God's Word we practice closed communion. Our faith is not exclusive but God says that we should have unity of faith and doctrine (which Communion expresses). As we receive His gift today we would ask all visitors and guests to refrain from receiving the sacrament until they speak to Pastor Bremer. We also ask that those members who have not communed in the past 6 months to also speak to the pastor before communing once again. 2 Corinthians 6:1–13

¹Working together with him, then, we appeal to you not to
receive the grace of God in vain. ²For he says,
“In a favorable time I listened to you,
and in a day of salvation I have helped you.”
Behold, now is the favorable time; behold, now is the day of
salvation. ³We put no obstacle in anyone’s way, so that no fault
may be found with our ministry, ⁴but as servants of God we
commend ourselves in every way: by great endurance, in
afflictions, hardships, calamities, ⁵beatings, imprisonments,
riots, labors, sleepless nights, hunger; ⁶by purity, knowledge,

patience, kindness, the Holy Spirit, genuine love; ⁷by truthful speech, and the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left; ⁸through honor and dishonor, through slander and praise.
