Deliverance Ministry Expectations

Knowing that God has spoken clearly in His Word concerning the character and responsibility of a person who serves others (Romans 12:3-8, 1 Peter 5:1-11), I will faithfully submit myself to God, to the Spiritual Freedom Network, the leadership of the Ministry Teams and uphold the following Expectations:

1. I will seek to maintain a close and intimate walk with the Lord.
2. I will pray regularly for my team leaders, fellow team members and people whom I serve.
3. I will submit myself to go through Deliverance with the Spiritual Freedom Network Leadership.
4. I understand that I am taking on a very important ministry role in this deliverance ministry, and therefore, I will be an example for the believers by:
 - Attending a church regularly
 - Living an obedient life to Christ in all areas of my life, and
 - I will devote myself to serving God and serving alongside the leaders and Members of my own church, as well as the Spiritual Freedom Network, with all humility.
5. I will support the Spiritual Freedom Network's vision, mission and Training Process.
6. I will not use any other deliverance methods or approaches (such as shamanistic or black magic) that are unbiblical and agree to use the process approved by the Spiritual Freedom Network.
7. I will maintain an open-to-change, teachable and coachable attitude.
8. Faithfully hold myself accountable to the Spiritual Freedom Network leadership.
9. Be positive and encouraging, endeavoring to maintain the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace and refrain from expressing negative attitudes through criticism, complaint or disapproval of my team members, leaders and other church leaders publically.

10. Keep confidential the personal confidential issues shared by my leaders and members.
11. Use the Personal Hindrance Inventory form before I begin any deliverance session
12. Promote and practice the deliverance process model that has been stated in the Breaking Chains of Darkness Manuel and in training classes of the Spiritual Freedom Network. I will not bring in other models or methods that are related to other religious practices, but are not in alignment with Scripture.
13. Not accuse or say that members of the church have demons (even if it is apparent that they do) or ask that they be delivered, unless they are the ones who ask to be delivered.
14. Be responsible for my own ministry if I go out of our area to do deliverance (other states or countries) and that Spiritual Freedom Network and the Deliverance Team will not be responsible for my ministry, unless I have been authorized by the Deliverance Team to represent them.
15. Come to the deliverance sessions that I am assigned to and be ready to minister to others; if I cannot, I will let my leader know.
16. When I need to take a leave of absence and when I am ready to come back after the leave, I will let me leader know.
17. Uphold these expectations. The day that I cannot do so, I will resign peacefully from my role on this ministry team and not cause any divisions or chaos. My name will be then be deleted from the Spiritual Freedom Network website.
