GUIDELINES FOR PERSONAL MINISTRY

The following guidelines have been established to help facilitate the personal ministry sessions:

- 1. How are ministry appointments made?
 - Anyone who desires personal ministry should contact the Spiritual Freedom Network or one of the deliverance teams under the ministry team tab at: www.demonfreetoday.com
- 2. What are the spiritual requirements for coming to the Spiritual Freedom Network for Deliverance?
 - (a). The person(s) desiring ministry must really want help. He or she must be serious about changing his/her life and keeping the deliverance after it is received.
 - (b). He/she must be born-again or want to become a Christian and willing to be accountable to a pastor or Christian friend following the session(s).
 - (c). He/she must be totally honest in all sessions with those who will be ministering deliverance to them:
 - All information given to the Deliverance Team is strictly confidential and will not be shared with anyone else where the person's name can be identified.
 - The person receiving ministry must be candid and forthright in answering all questions as this aids the deliverance process.
 - (d). The person receiving ministry must be an active participant in his/her own deliverance and in making practical changes in his/her situations in life.
- 3. The person receiving ministry understands that the Deliverance Team cannot guarantee, for reasons inherent in human nature, an end to all problems or changes that may be desired in coming for deliverance ministry.

4. What are the practical requirements for coming to the Spiritual Freedom Network for deliverance?

The person receiving ministry agrees to be prompt and on time for all sessions. Should you need to cancel your session, please contact us as quickly as possible.

If traveling from out of town, the person receiving ministry agrees to provide all of their own transportation, lodging and meals.

5. What are the financial requirements for coming to the Spiritual Freedom Network for deliverance?

Although there are many expense in the ministry, such as website fees, broadcast cost, workshops, media, video, etc. as well as time and effort...

There is NO CHARGE for Ministry of Deliverance (Matt 15:22-26 ... deliverance is the children bread...)

However, love offerings are appreciated.

The Deliverance Team members are volunteers who provide their time and services free (freely we have received and freely we give) to those who want ministry.

However, the Spiritual Freedom Network is supported by contributions for written material and voluntary offerings. Any contributions to The Spiritual Freedom Network are tax deductible and are used to cover expenses of the ministry.

6. What should a person expect in the first session for deliverance?

The candidate who is coming for deliverance can contact who they desire from the deliverance teams listed on the webpage. If now selection is made, the Spiritual Freedom Network will assign a Deliverance Team at their discretion.

At the time of the first session, one of our Spiritual Freedom Network Teams that is assigned, will be prepared by fasting and prayer to meet with the person and provide quality deliverance ministry to people requesting personal ministry.

The first sessions generally average one to two hours, sometimes longer and additional sessions usually average between one and two hours.

Persons coming from out of town can schedule one or more days of sessions at a time.

Be assured that our Deliverance Teams come prepared:

- To give their total, undivided attention and focus upon the person(s) coming for ministry during all sessions.
- They pledge to give themselves unreservedly to him/her and allow the Holy Spirit to lead all the session(s).
- The Deliverance Team cannot guarantee, for reasons inherent in human nature, an end to all problems or changes desired to the person(s) coming for deliverance ministry. However, most people do experience various levels of deliverance and healing from life's hurts.
