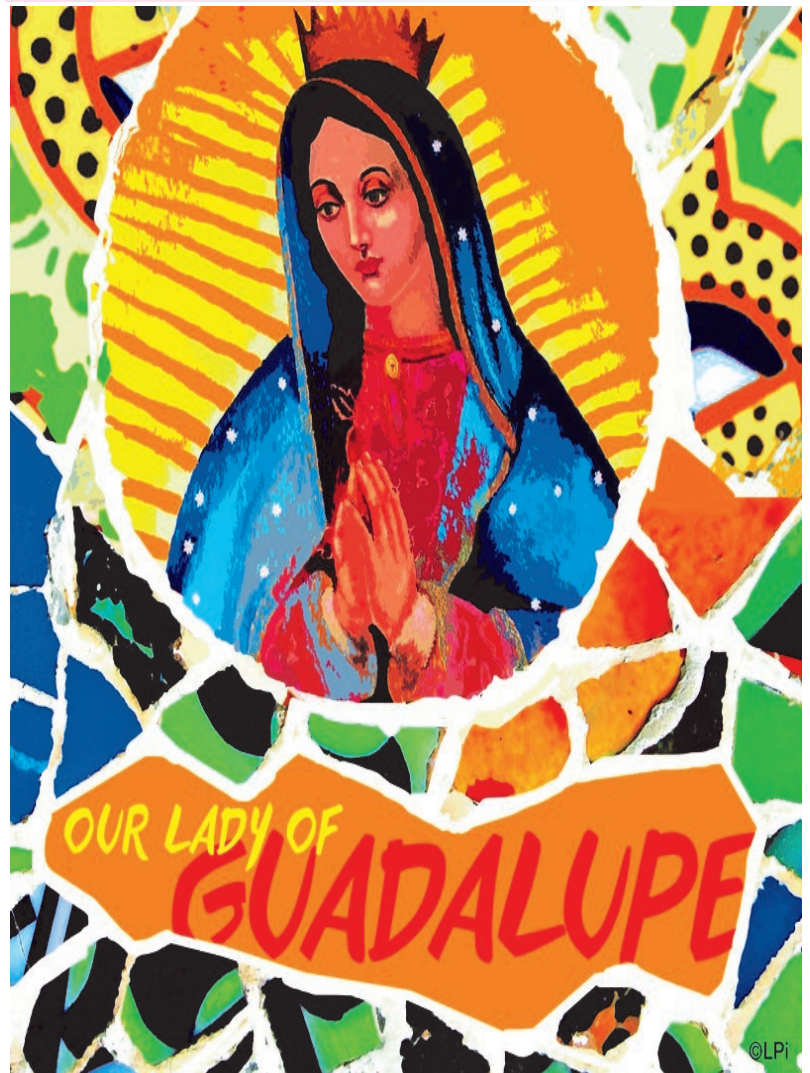

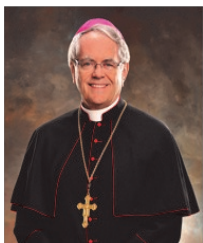

## **"SIMBANG GABI" - December 15-23, 2021**



**Simbang Gabi** is a traditional custom among Filipinos originating from the Philippines during its early years of Christianity. It is a nine (9) series of novena masses celebrated in catholic churches in the early morning leading up to Christmas eve in joyous anticipation of baby Jesus birth.

This is a very much desired Filipino religious tradition for families to stay late or wake up early, attend mass and fill many churches. After the liturgy, delicious Filipino food and delicacies are served and shared

by families. Thus this novena becomes both a religious and social gathering.

In the Diocese of Las Vegas, these novena masses are rotated around the city, celebrated in different parishes at their regular mass time, as published in parish bulletins. Parishioners are invited to attend and participate in the novena. The Pastor/Associate at the assigned parish may preside the liturgy. Visiting priests may be welcome to concelebrate. The readings of the day are read and proclaimed. A simple reception/fellowship usually takes place after mass.

### **Why Register to the Parish?**

Why is it so important that we register in a parish?  
Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. Often people attend Mass at a parish for months or sometimes years, but never officially register.

Registering at Holy Family is the expression of your commitment to being part of our parish community. Being a registered parishioner also makes the process much simpler when it is time for receiving sacraments, registering for faith formation (religious education), sponsoring a sacrament recipient and even planning funerals. We are often asked to provide affidavits for baptism and confirmation sponsors. We can only do this if a person is a registered, active, and contributing member in our parish. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish. So, are you a registered parishioner? If not, please register.

Registration forms are available in the vestibule of the Church.

*(Young adults 18 and over, living in their parent's household should be registered separately.  
This is especially IMPORTANT for marriage and baptism preparation.)*
