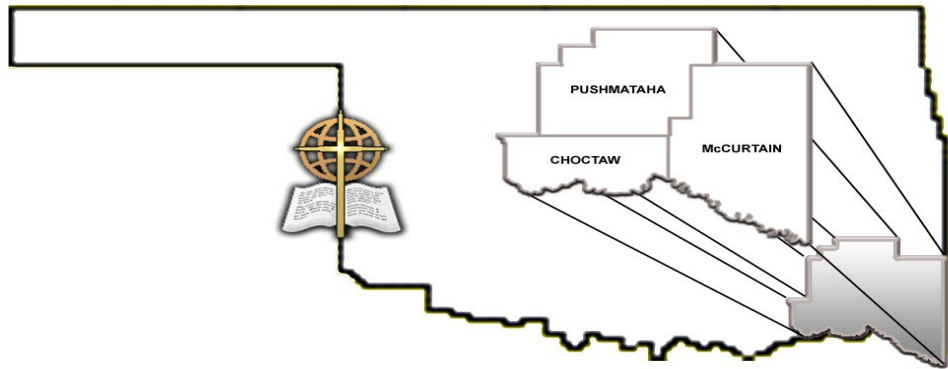


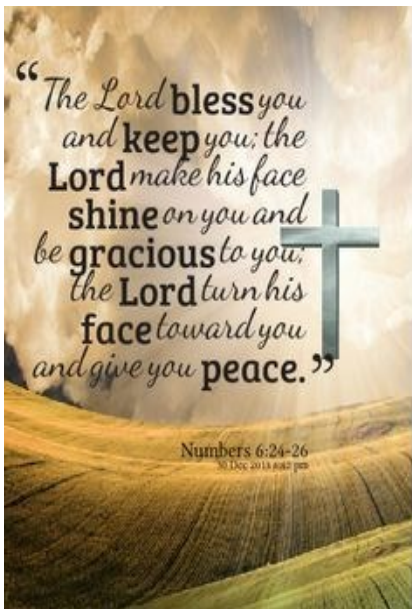

## **From Bro. Otis:**

I trust everyone had a wonderful Christmas. What we have just experienced (celebrating the birth of our savior) is at least one of the most special events we will ever celebrate. Now we move on looking forward to a Happy New Year. Consider the following observations.

Can we agree that we will never experience the happiness that Jesus wants us to experience without salvation? Everyone is happy at the time of salvation, but many seem to lose that happiness over a period of time. We can maintain our happiness by following Jesus after salvation. Maybe we lose our happiness over a period of time because we are spiritually asleep. As the years have gone by, we have become more and more drowsy until we are completely spiritually comatose.

Romans 13:11-12 says **11 And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed.**

**12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.**

If we are to enjoy true happiness this coming year, we must wake up out of our spiritual sleep. Too many believers are slumbering and paying no attention to what is going on in the world; too many are not watching; too many are not observing the signs of the time. Too many are complacent and slothful, lazily passing through life with little commitment to serving Christ. Our salvation and the salvation of our family and friends is nearer than when we believed. The word "salvation" is being used in a future sense, referring to the glorious day when we shall be fully saved. It is the day when our salvation will be consummated, and we will be delivered from this present evil world and perfected forever to live in the presence of God. The point is dramatic: the day is nearer than when we believed. Awaken out of sleep—arouse yourself—get up—pay attention.

As we begin this new year, let us pursue happiness. Let us determine that we will have happiness by having good fellowship. First of all, we must have fellowship with Jesus.

**1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. The starting point to happiness is having good fellowship with Christ.**

Secondly, let us pursue happiness through fellowship with Christians.

**Psalm 133:1-3 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! 2 It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments; 3 As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, even life for evermore.**

As we begin another new year, let us determine that we will not go through this year spiritually asleep. Let us wake up and determine that we are going to be happy this year by having fellowship with Jesus and our Christian brothers and sisters.
