- I. What Do You Have When You Have Jesus in Your Life? (Isaiah 9:6-7)
  - Titles for Jesus show that we can count on Jesus to "Exceed" our Expectations.
    - 1. Wonderful Counselor
      - This is an expectation of WISDOM.
      - We can Trust Jesus to "Lead and Guide".
    - 2. Mighty God
      - This is an expectation of POWER.
      - We can Trust Jesus to be our "Mighty Warrior".
    - 3. Everlasting Father
      - This is an expectation of CARE.
      - We can Trust Jesus to be our "Eternal Provider".
    - 4. Prince of Peace
      - This is an expectation of WHOLENESS.
      - We can Trust Jesus to "Calm our Fears".

There are three kinds of PEACE that God Gives (1) PEACE on the Upside (PEACE with God) Romans 5:1; (2) PEACE on the Inside (PEACE of God) Phil. 4:7; and (3) PEACE on the Outside (PEACE with Each Other) Hebrews 12:14!
