

## USING EDMONTON PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION TO & FROM AIRPORT & CENTURY PARK TRANSIT STATION



You will need \$5 cash (Canadian) to board the bus, one-way ticket. As you leave the Canadian Border Security area there is an ICE (International Currency Exchange) booth between doors 9 & 10. This is the same area where you will pick up your checked luggage. Map of Airport

Century Park is the southern end of Edmonton's Light Rail Transit (LRT). The bus to and from the Edmonton Airport will pick-up and drop-off passengers here. You will transfer to either ETS Bus or LRT Service from this station where you can purchase passes. <u>ETS Website Trip Planner</u>

No transfer to regular ETS service (bus or LRT).

**LUGGAGE** Here are a few things to note when travelling with your luggage to ensure a safe and comfortable experience.

First come/first served. Passengers already on board with their luggage are not required to move their luggage to accommodate additional passengers. However, please be considerate, and when possible, put personal belongings on your lap to accommodate additional passengers.

All passenger luggage\* must be placed in the luggage racks or on the floor in front of the seat. No passenger luggage is allowed in the aisle.

Passengers are responsible for handling their own luggage. Bus operators are not required to assist passengers with luggage movement.

Provincial requirements dictate that the bus operator will not move the bus if there is passenger luggage in the aisle.

Edmonton Transit System is not responsible for lost or damaged passenger luggage. Call 780-496-1622 for Lost & Found. ETS

Should you notice a suspicious package at Century Park Transit Centre or on the bus please notify the bus operator or call Transit Watch at 780-442-4900.



Once you have arrived at Century Park you will need to transfer to the LRT station. The Send Conference was held at the Coast Edmonton Plaza Hotel. To get there from Century Park you take the Capitol Line (Blue Line) and either exit at Corona Station or the Bay/Enterprise Station (Suggested stop). Trip is approximately 18-20 minutes. Both of these stations are underground. You would then walk to the hotel (Approximately 2-3 blocks)

The cost for the tickets is variable. A single ticket is \$3.25 or you can get a 10 adult ticket pass for \$24.75. Youth fares (6-17) or senior adults over 65+ can get a 10 ride pass for \$21.50. An all day transit pass, good for LRT and Buses, costs \$9.25.

You can purchase tickets via vending machine at all stations or <u>online</u>.

By using the ETS Buses and LRT Service you can get to pretty much any where in Edmonton. This will make it much easier should you be picked up by a pastor or host.
