As churches we participate in ministry for our members daily. Doing local missions means we do projects for people who have no church affiliation.

Your church can set up one day to do local missions and come together to participate as a group. Your church can come together on one day and each Sunday school class can have different projects. Each Sunday school class can set up their own project and decide the best time for them to participate in that particular project.

Local mission projects can be:

- Mowing and cleaning a yard for a lost family or individual.
- Giving out water and snacks at an intersection with scripture verses.
- Baking cookies for firemen and policemen and delivering them to the station.
- Taking snacks to a nursing home and visit residents.
- Visiting shut-ins and take lotions and other needed items.
- Having a car wash for free.
- Painting a house.
- Building a new fence for a senior adult.
- Roofing a house.

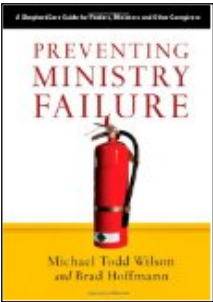
