#### **Urn Garden Lots**

Lots are two feet square and accommodate two cremains and one monument. Prices as of June 2022 and are subject to change.

### **Memorial Pillar Spaces**

Space for bronze memorial plaques is available in two sizes. Prices as of June 2022 and are subject to change.

Large: 4 x 9 inches, mounted on the pillar narrow side \$200

Small: 3 x 8 inches, mounted on the pillar wide side. \$100

#### **Memorials for Urn Sites**

Required monument style is available from Witherbee and Whalen, Canton. Prices as of June 2022 are subject to change.





N or S wide side


E or W narrow side

# Rules and Regulations

#### Urn Garden Lot J

In addition to the rules and regulations applying to Bayside, the following rules and regulations apply specifically to the urn garden.

- 1. No additional decoration or plantings may be added to a registered site, but Bayside welcomes contributions in memoriam to improve the garden's common space.
- 2. Monuments for urn sites must be of durable stone, no wider than 18 inches nor taller than 14 inches, and with a slant face. Color is optional. Lot holders may have the stone face engraved or apply a bronze plaque to it. Veterans' plaques may be attached to their backs.
- 3. The monument must be centered on the site and face the walkway. It is recommended that a concrete pad at least 4 inches thick be installed under the monument and not visible from the walkway. The monument may be erected on a registered site at any time by a professional.
- 4. Contiguous sites may share a monument of standard size placed on the boundary between them.
- 5. Registered lots display a red brick beside a numbered grey brick.
- 6. Registered spaces on the memorial pillars in the urn garden are for bronze memorial plaques.
- 7. Registrants may select any unclaimed designated space on either pillar
- 8. Those honored by a plaque need not be interred at Bayside.
- 9. Plaques may be either 3x8 inch or 4x9 inch bronze plaques, and must be installed by professionals.
- 10. The sexton has final authority to approve the inscriptions on a plaque.
