The Pines

The new Pines urn garden at Bayside Cemetery in Potsdam, N.Y., is now open for the interment of cremated remains or memorialization. This special part of Bayside has been designed specifically for those who have chosen cremation.

Built in the summer of 2020, The Pines is located in a quiet, shady location of Bayside Cemetery near the banks of the beautiful Raquette River.

The Pines is the only landscaped urn garden in St. Lawrence County. Hydrangea, coral bells, coneflowers and ferns decorate the garden, along with a stone bench centerpiece for rest and reflection.



Surrounding the flower beds are numbered stones to show the placement of future raised stone markers for urn interments.

The Pines features 150 sites for one to two cremation urns with raised stone site markers. These sites are less costly than a full casket lot and remain attractive over time, as they don't grow over with grass.

Even if the cremated remains are not available for interment, memorial plaques may be mounted on the columns of the stone centerpiece.

Perpetual care of the garden and walkways is provided, and The Pines is accessible to those with mobility impairments.

About Bayside Cemetery

Established in 1865, Bayside Cemetery is on the National Register of Historic Places for its architectural and historical significance. Since its creation, Bayside has served the region as a parklike setting to commune with nature and the memories of those who have gone before us. Its 42 acres of landscaped grounds are open to visitors each day.

Bayside's founders introduced cultural features of winding roads, tombstones, and memorials to merge with the natural features of hills, water, and trees. The resulting landscape of restful beauty bids visitors and the bereaved to return to reconnect with past family and friends, to contemplate nature, and to reflect.

Bayside Cemetery is owned and operated by the Bayside Cemetery Association and registered with the New York Attorney General as a 501(c)(13) tax-exempt charitable organization.



Directions to Bayside Cemetery

Bayside Cemetery is located just south of the Village of Potsdam on the west bank of the Raquette River. At the corner of Maple St. (Route 11) and Clarkson Ave., turn south onto Clarkson Ave. (County Route 59) and proceed one mile. The cemetery is on your left.

Approaching Potsdam from the south, on U. S. Highway 56, in Hannawa Falls, turn left onto County Route 59. Continue north for 4 miles. Bayside Cemetery is on your right as you see the "Village of Potsdam" sign.
