

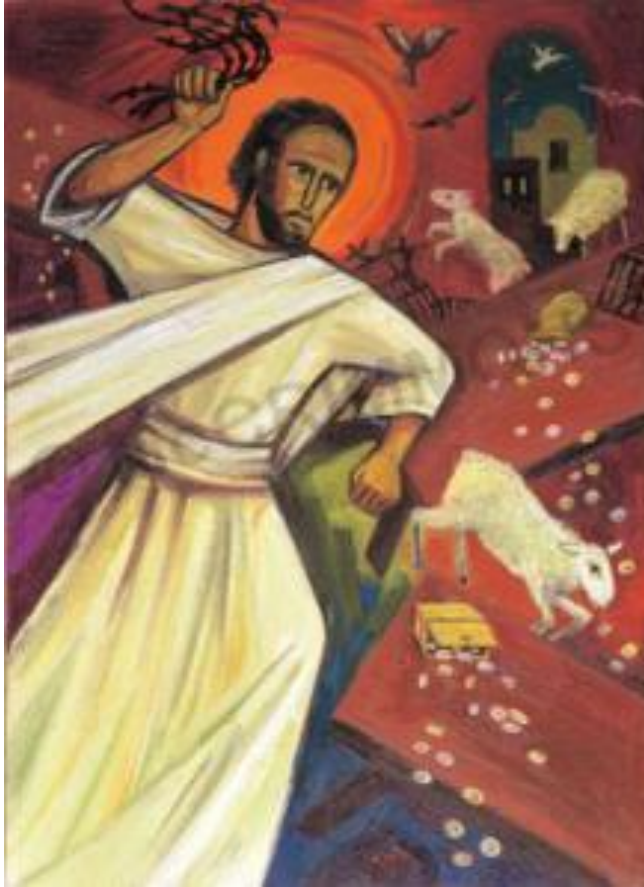

Lenten Study: Daily readings continue and the group's next bi-weekly gathering is this Tuesday, March 6th at 5PM. The remaining bi-weekly gatherings are March 20th, and April 3rd.

THE GOOD BOOK CLUB: Bishop William Love joins Presiding Bishop Michael Curry in inviting you and all Episcopalians to participate in the Good Book Club as part of our Lenten and Easter discipline. The intent is for each of us to read the Gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles during the Lent and Easter Season following a daily reading schedule published by Forward Movement.
