**ALPHA COURSE:** The Alpha Course is a series of sessions exploring the Christian faith, typically run over eleven weeks. Each talk looks at a different question around faith and is designed to create conversation. Alpha is run all over the globe, and everyone is welcome. St. Peter's spring Alpha Course has begun and is held in the Pumpelly Room every Wednesday evening from 6PM to 7:30PM. The course will run through May 29th. We hope you will consider joining us.

**LENTEN EVENSONG:** Remaining Fridays: March 22nd, 29th, April 5th and 12th. Please join us for our Lenten Evensong services which are held every Friday evening during Lent beginning at 5:45PM. We invite you to conclude your work week with this opportunity for worship and reflection.

**The Last Supper:** On Sunday, April 7th during the 10:30AM service the Sunday School will reenact the Last Supper. This will include the story of Jesus and his disciples, washing of our feet and taking part in the Most Holy Bread and Wine (juice). All are welcome to take part in this wonderful activity.

**Easter Egg Coloring:** On Sunday, April 14th the Sunday School children will be coloring Easter eggs during the 10:30AM service. Please allow them to dress in "old clothes" - but just in case, there will be a small number of smocks available. We hope all of the children will join in this fun event!

**GOOD FRIDAY MUSIC:** Following the Noon service on Good Friday, April 19th, the choir will sing the *Brockes Passion* by G. F. Handel, accompanied by a chamber orchestra. The full title of *Brockes Passion* is *Der für die Sünde der Welt gemarterte und sterbende Jesus* ("The Story of Jesus, Suffering and Dying for the Sins of the World"). The Choir will sing an English language version of the Brockes Passion, edited to fit the context of our Good Friday observance.
