Coffee Hour: Please join us for coffee hour after the 8:30AM and 10:30AM Services. All are welcome.

Youth Sunday: Today is Youth Sunday where we offer **Children's Chapel** for our youngest members. In lieu of our traditional Sunday School offering, pre-Confirmation youth and Sunday School teachers celebrate a Youth Eucharist in the Pumpelly Room during the service. Children begin worship with the parents in the main Sanctuary and following the first reading the children are invited to process into Children's Chapel for their own Gospel message, homily and instructed Eucharist service.

Pentecost: Next Sunday, June 4th is Pentecost. We will have wonderful services including a baptism at the 10:30AM service. As is customary within our tradition, we are encouraging you to wear red to church on Pentecost (red symbolizes the fire of the Holy Spirit).

Women's Bible Study: Tuesdays at 3PM during May and June. Mother Sue welcomes the women of the church to join her for a study on 1st and 2nd Thessalonians presented by Beth Moore. They read and complete reflection questions during the week at home and then gather together on Tuesday afternoons to watch and discuss the video series. Bible Study: This Wednesday, May 31st is the last Acts of the Apostles Bible Study.

ORGAN AND CHOIR CONCERT: Friday, June 2nd at 7:30PM a concert by Vaughn Mauren and the Choir of St. Peter's Church. Vaughn, Organist and Choirmaster of St. James's Episcopal Church in West Hartford, CT, returns to Albany to perform. His recital will be supplemented by choral selections sung by the choir, as they prepare to travel to England this summer. Vaughn will serve as accompanist for that trip.
