BOOK AND BIBLE STUDY: Our Father Who Art in Heaven; Πάτερ ἡμῶν ὁ ἐν τοῖς οὐρανοῖς. Referencing Matthew 6:9-13 and *Abba: Meditations on the Lord's Prayer*, by Evelyn Underhill, Mother Sue invites you to join our Book and Bible Study on Tuesday evenings from 5PM To 6:30PM in the Vestry Room. The second study session will be held this Tuesday, September 25th.

Youth Sunday: Youth Sunday returns next Sunday, September 30th and will continue to be held on the last Sunday of each month. On the last Sunday of each month we invite the children of our parish to take special part at the 10:30AM service. The teens will fill important roles during the service in the Sanctuary. Additionally, we will be offering **Children's Chapel** for our youngest members. In lieu of our traditional Sunday School offering, pre-Confirmation youth and Sunday School teachers will celebrate a Youth Eucharist in the Pumpelly Room during the service. Children will begin worship with the parents in the main Sanctuary and following the first reading the children will be invited to process into Children's Chapel for their own Gospel message, homily and instructed Eucharist service. Please speak to Fr. Hartt or Mtr. Sue if your child would like to have a special role during an upcoming Youth Sunday.

ALPHA SERIES: Alpha is a series of sessions exploring the Christian faith, typically run over eleven weeks. Each talk looks at a different question around faith and is designed to create conversation. Alpha is run all over the globe, and everyone is welcome. St. Peter's will run the Alpha course formally in the spring. Fr. Hartt is looking for volunteers to experience the program in a somewhat accelerated form. You do not need to commit to being a discussion leader later. The talks are worthwhile in themselves. The first session will be on Wednesday, October 3rd at 6PM.
