Coffee Hour: Please join us for coffee hour after the 8:30AM and 10:30AM Services. All are welcome.

Youth Sunday: Today is Youth Sunday. On the last Sunday of each month we invite the children of our parish to take special part at the 10:30AM service. The teens will fill important roles during the service in the Sanctuary. Additionally, we will be offering **Children's Chapel** for our youngest members. In lieu of our traditional Sunday School offering, pre-Confirmation youth and Sunday School teachers will celebrate a Youth Eucharist in the Pumpelly Room during the service. Children will begin worship with the parents in the main Sanctuary and following the first reading the children will be invited to process into Children's Chapel for their own Gospel message, homily and instructed Eucharist service. Please speak to Fr. Hartt or Mtr. Sue if your child would like to have a special role during an upcoming Youth Sunday.

Confirmation Classes: Confirmation instruction for adults and youth (aged 13+) has begun. The class is co-led by Fr. Hartt and Mtr. Sue and meets every Sunday during the months of November through January (except 12/24 and 12/31) after the 10:30AM service. We are preparing candidates to be Confirmed on Sunday, February 11, 2018 here at St. Peter's Church during Bishop Love's Visitation. Please speak with Fr. Hartt or Mother Sue if you (or your youth) are interested.

Advent: Advent begins next Sunday, December 3rd. Advent calendars will be distributed and Advent wreaths and candles will be available to the congregation.

Christmas Pageant Rehearsal: Next Sunday, December 3rd, all children that want to participate in our Annual Christmas Pageant should report to the Sunday School rooms to get your parts, try on costumes and do a little rehearsing. The pageant will be performed during the 10:30AM service on Sunday, December 10th. Please have the children arrive in costume at 9:30AM on the 10th.

HANDEL'S MESSIAH: Next Sunday, December 3rd at 3PM St. Peter's Choir will present a performance of Handel's *Messiah*, accompanied by a chamber orchestra. There is no charge for admission and all are welcome to this performance.

Service of Remembrance: Wednesday, December 6th at 7PM. An ecumenical prayer service will be held to gather and remember our departed loved ones. Each remembrance will be signified by the lighting of a candle and an ornament placed on our Remembrance Tree. A reception follows the service in the Pumpelly Room. We thank Judy Burns for coordinating this annual prayer event.

Blessing Bags: To assist and offer comfort for the women who stay in our overflow shelter the Daughters of the King will be assembling Blessing Bags on Sunday, December 10th. These are small (quart size) bags of good will and hospitality that are given to people who may need some cheer and comfort. Please consider bringing an offering of women's care products such as tooth paste, tooth brush, a comb, scented lotion, hair rubber bands, mints, candies, wipes, granola bars, travel deodorant, lip balms, band aids, cotton swabs, small cracker packets, Slim Jim snacks, feminine pads/wipes, small tissue packets, small note pads and pens can also be useful. Products that contain alcohol such as mouth wash and hand sanitizer should not be included (hand sanitizer wipes are ok).

ADVENT IV SUNDAY: On Sunday morning, December 24th, please note that there will only be one morning service to celebrate Advent IV. This service will be a regular Sunday morning 8:30AM Holy Communion service. The 10:30AM service will not be held. Christmas Eve services will be held later that day at 4:30PM and 10PM.
