Thought Questions from Episode 3

1. Verse 15 begins with “For this reason”. What about the previous statements by Paul motivates such a passionate prayer? Describe some realizations that might make your prayer life more passionate.
2. Why do you think Paul felt such appreciation for the Christians in Ephesus? Talk about someone in your life that you’ve been a spiritual mentor to. How has that relationship made you thankful?
3. Jerry mentioned that you can “know about Jesus” without “knowing Jesus”. What do you think would help someone know the “person”, not just the “facts” about Jesus?
4. Paul mentions three things he prays that the recipients grasped more fully: hope, riches, and power”. Pick one of those ideas and talk about how Jesus has provided you a more real sense of hope, riches, or power.
5. Paul says that when God raised Jesus, he empowered him and “placed everything under his feet” and made him “head over everything”. Is there a situation where you may question that? How do you think trusting that “power” could help you through a difficult time?
