## **Opening Prayer**

One: Holy God, you have been a steady presence throughout time, from the dawn of creation to this pandemic season. You have called each generation to face the challenges of their time. You have given us different gifts and technologies to help us work for the causes of love and justice. We pray that you would be with us now, in this important time and in this virtual space. Draw us together as one community, one church, so that we might be called and blessed today. Comfort us, inspire us, and renew us, so that we are ready to serve. Amen.

#### **Invitation to Confession**

One: The ways in which we gather as the church may be changing, but the ways in which we seek and find forgiveness and grace are still the same. We quiet our hearts. We admit to God the shame and guilt we carry, both for the things we have done that we regret and the things we failed to do that haunt us, as individuals and as a society. This is how we release our burdens and find freedom. (A chime calls us to a moment of silence.)

## **Prayer of Confession**

All: Holy One, we confess that we say we await your call for a time such as this, but we quickly turn away when we hear it. We're not sure how to navigate through this time. We admit that as happy as we are to see each other's faces, sometimes we despair at yet another Zoom meeting. We acknowledge that we have used technology in ways that hinder and hurt ourselves and others. We know you are on the move and calling us to move with you, but we struggle to know how to follow you faithfully. You offer us new possibilities and yet we get stuck trying to do things in familiar ways. Give us strength, renewed vision, and hope for the future so that we can answer you call and transform the world. Amen.

#### **Words of Assurance**

One: God is on the move, but God has promised to never leave us behind. Living into a new creation requires practice, learning, and the knowledge that we will be forgiven again and again as we grow into everything God knows we can be. Take heart. You are God's beloved now and in all the days to come!
