UCCSV Provides Site to Train Young Music Tutors and Future Composers

For three evenings in late July, UCCSV was the site of the Tacy Foundation's training for its innovative **Piano Pals** and **Composer's Circle** programs.

The Piano Pals program, entering its 6th year in Montgomery County Public Schools, serves economically disadvantaged elementary school children at Title One schools and now expanding to Housing Opportunity Commission after school programs. This program matches youth mentors with young children interested in learning music. More than 50 students received training at UCCSV to mentor underprivileged children for Piano Pals!

Composers Circle, which was led by recent high school graduate and UCCSV member George Benskin IV, is focused on inspiring children to develop creativity, critical thinking, and confidence through music composition sessions. Composers' Circle is in its 2nd year.
