This Sunday at UCCSV

This week we start a new series at UCCSV about living into our callings from God. Many people think a calling is only for pastors or ordained ministers. But in fact people are called by God all the time. Sometimes this ends up being a vacation or a career, sometimes this is a calling to care for one's family, sometimes it's about volunteer work, and sometimes it's just a

calling to live our entire lives a certain way regardless of our work or home life. Callings can change throughout our lives as well. And callings aren't just for individuals. They can be for families, for organizations or whole communities. Churches can be called to specific work or ministries. During this next month we will explore the whys and hows of callings; calls to justice, calls to proclaim truth or hope, calls that feel overwhelming, calls that require us to make specific life choices, and calls to mentor or to be mentored by others. This Sunday we begin with exploring baptism. It is at Jesus' baptism that God announces that Jesus is seen for who he is. loved for who he is, and equipped to respond to his calling. Can the same thing happen for us? What about those who aren't baptized? What about infant baptisms that we don't remember? Is God really calling us right now and how would we know? Join us as we explore these questions and more.
