# Wider Church News - Potomac Association Spring Meeting

Last weekend the Potomac Association (PA), our regional body of the UCC, met at the United Christian Parish in Reston, Va. At the meeting the Association considered and voted on changes to the PA By-laws and Constitution. We also heard from our new Conference Minister, Freeman Palmer, and voted on a new slate of board members and committee participants for the upcoming year. It was clear the Spirit was moving as several positions that had remained unfilled, like Treasurer and several committee members, suddenly had volunteers ready and eager to be a part of the work of the wider church.

The Potomac Association's board is made up of Moderator, Associate Moderator, Treasurer, Associate Treasurer, Scribe, an At-Large Member and the Committee Chairs of the four standing PA committees - Committee on Ministry (which deals with the fitness and health of clergy and churches in the region), Spiritual Formation (Christian Education), Justice and Witness (work on social action and justice causes), and Higher Education (oversees outreach to local college campuses and funds campus ministries). Wider church participation is a very important aspect of a church's ministry. We aren't alone in God's work and when we work with other like minded congregations, we can multiply our impact.

UCCSV should be pleased to know that we are a church working to make an impact in our neighborhood and our region by engaging with, and volunteering for, the Potomac Association. Christie Holland has been a part of the Committee on Ministry since 2016. And at this meeting Pastor Holly stepped up to be Associate Moderator for a two year term while Court Buchanan volunteered to be Associate Treasurer. We're excited to see where the Spirit

takes our Association and our church in the year to come!
