This Sunday at UCCSV

We're celebrating Thanksgiving at UCC Seneca Valley with a special worship service designed to help us quiet our souls and consider what we are thankful for as we move into this holiday week. It's so easy for us to get caught up in the anxiety and stress and constant doing that seems to go hand in hand with big holidays like Thanksgiving. We can forget why we even celebrate. Sunday's worship will give you an opportunity to help you remember.
