## **Leadership Transition this Month for Church Council**

Normally UCCSV would have a leadership transition in May when the congregation elected a new Council to serve for the upcoming year. Because of the pandemic and juggling with moving all church activities online this summer back in June the congregation voted to have our previous leadership stay in place until such a time as we could do a leadership transition with a minimum of disruption. The time for this change has finally come. This coming Saturday the members of the outgoing Council and the members of the incoming Council will meet together for a Retreat/Orientation by Zoom. Then later in the month, at our September Council meeting, the new Council will meet for the first time and continue to lead our church until next May.

We thank those who are stepping off of Council for the fantastic job they have done over the last few months to lead our congregation through this difficult transition. Claro Yu has been a fantastic Moderator and his steady leadership has been invaluable. Claro is stepping back from Council for a well-deserved break and to focus more on helping our church to fully implement our strategic planning work. Susan Pearcy has been a wonderful At-Large Member, organizing church

wide community art projects, reminding Council of the needs of the entire congregation, and serving on Trustees. We are so thankful for her service. Finally, Colby Harmon has led the Social Action Committee for several years now helping us to get more focused on our giving for Germantown Help and connecting us with outside organizations working on immigration, environmental justice, and LGBTQ+ concerns. He also has organized events around racial justice issues and led us through the transition years of letting go of the beloved Emergency Assistance Program and focusing more on other community wide concerns. Colby will be moving over to one of the At-Large positions on Council in this coming year.
