

Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.

Hebrews 10:24

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

A big change is coming in my life starting in January! For a year now, one of our sister congregations, Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Baraboo has been vacant. Their pastor retired and for a year, they had their own vacancy pastor leading them in worship and helping them to hold fast to the confession of our hope. But now it is time for someone else to be their vacancy pastor.

That task will fall upon my shoulders. What does it mean that I am a vacancy pastor? It means that I am to oversee their ministry of Word and Sacrament much as I do at Trinity. It looks like that means leading them in worship or making sure someone can lead them in worship. It means that I am a temporary pastor to the congregation while they are vacant while at the same time I am still Trinity's pastor.

Why be a vacancy pastor? Well as our Bible verse of the month states, to help the brothers and sisters in Christ in Baraboo to hold fast to the confession of Christ. To make sure that God's people are given God's good gifts of Word and Sacrament during this time of transition. To make sure that their sick and homebound members get appropriate pastoral care. To help them continue in their ministry in Baraboo.

But I am still called to be Trinity's pastor! I will still be leading worship at Trinity. My office will still be at Trinity. I am happy to be your pastor and look forward to us together holding fast to that confession of hope in Christ Jesus.

For that is why I have been called to you. To help you hold to that confession that you have hope in Christ Jesus who died on the cross and rose from the dead. Everything else in this world will let you down, but not Jesus. He defeated sin. He defeated death. He defeated the devil for you. He has a hope for you even when everything seems bleak. He is Your hope. His hope will never let you down. Because He is faithful.

As brothers and sisters in Christ, we are called to not only be faithful to one another, but also to our neighboring sister congregations. So that together, we can all as the body of Christ, one day see that hope fully realized in Christ's return.


Epiphany worship will take place on Wednesday, Jan. 5 at 7pm.
