

In all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. ~ Romans 8:37

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

When you think of the word conqueror, what do you think of? Do you think of violence and destruction? Do you think of some of history's great conquerors like Alexander the Great or Atilla the Hun? Do you think of the children's game, King of the Mountain, where the victor is the one who conquered the mountain of snow and knocked everyone else off the mountain?

Usually, when we hear the word conqueror it is a bloody, violent image that we get. After all, conquerors in this world have to take things by force. Often times, conquerors want things that belong to someone else. So they have to take it, steal it, fight over it, and the like. It can become quite the messy situation very quickly.

But our Bible verse of the month tells us that we are more than conquerors. We are supposed to be above all this messy stuff. We are more than conquerors because conquerors want to reign over this world, but we want to reign with Jesus into eternity. We are more than conquerors because the world thought it could conquer its maker. Even when it got messy, even when He became bloodied, even when it became a sticky situation on the cross, Jesus conquered the world. Through your faith in Him, He makes you more than conquerors.

I don't know if there is any greater message as we hope to be on the back side of a pandemic. This world was brought to a halt by a virus you can't see with the naked eye! It seemingly conquered the world. But with everything that conquers this world, it is short lived. Even for those that have been overcome by this disease, they are still more than conquerors through Jesus. For us who have lived through this interesting and distressing time, it is a reminder that we are more than conquerors because of Jesus. For those who wonder what their future will hold, we know that our future is with Jesus. For those who question what is next, we know that whatever this world throws at us, whatever conqueror tries to run our life next, that ultimately, in the long run, it won't matter. For Jesus has conquered it all. He graciously says to you, "Be more than what this world offers you. Be more than conquerors and reign with me forever."
