



Souper Bowl Sunday!

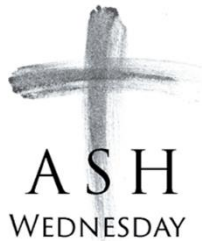
We collected \$349.00 and 147 canned goods! This year 3972 groups participated in the Souper Bowl, with \$8,660,460 in cash and food being collected.
