ministries for children, the primary ones are the Good News Club and the 5-Day Club. These ministries take place in neighborhood settings such as homes, backyards, schools and community centers all over the world. The programs are designed to bring the gospel to children at their level in their environment. CEF also has fair camping, open-air and internet ministries for children. Last year, the combined ministries reached over 20.4 million children worldwide with the Good News. The international headquarters of CEF is located in Warrenton, Missouri. The ministry was founded in 1937.


